#### Public Website

The Deepfishman website was open in April, i.e. at month 1 of the project while it was due at month 8.

The public section of the project includes general information on the project and Case studies. The leaflet and the DoW are available on the Website.

The website includes a stakeholder section. This section is now mainly about the stakeholder workshop held on 29 and 30 June in Brussels. Document from the workshop (presentations made and workshop report) are available in this section. The website also includes a section where access is restricted to project partners. This section have been used by partners to upload data to be used in the project workpackages. In particular, assessment data for stocks exploited by Case Study fisheries have been uploaded on the website for all case studies.

### <u>WIKI</u>

A wiki has been developed by MRI (partner 12) and was open in September 2009 (month M6 of the project). The wiki will become the main web communication tool of the project as it allows a more interactive activity. The wiki is organized with pages in several languages. At the moment (December 2009, month 9 of the project), mainly English pages have been written.

A web survey to identify Deepfishman stakeholders have been launched. It was advertised on the wiki and was also distributed to stakeholder lists by the subcontractors Sophie des Clers, the coordinator and partners.
